



## ***SUPPER ROCK NEIGHBORHOOD RESIDENTS:***

**Please follow the guidelines issued by Solid Waste Department.** According to the Solid Waste Department, **trash bins are to be removed from the street within 24 hours after pickup.** Trash bins not removed from the street cause a dangerous traffic hazard. Our neighborhood can have high winds any time during the year. With such high winds, empty trash bins will be blown into the street creating a dangerous traffic hazard (especially at night). All trash bins should be removed from the street before 7:00 a.m. Tuesday. The area between the property line and the street is city property and cannot be used for trash bin storage. The trash bins need to be placed on your property.

**If you have more than one trash bin, the trash bins should be placed 5 ft apart to be emptied.** Please don't overfill a trash bin. If a trash bin is too heavy, the truck cannot pick up the trash bin. Rocks, gravel, or dirt are not items for the trash bins. Call 761-8100 to schedule a request for pickup of rocks, gravel, or dirt.

Recycle items will be picked up every week on garbage day. Call 761-8100 for information on types of recyclable items.

Call the Solid Waste Department to arrange pickup of **household items that you place on the curb.** The call must be made between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. on **Friday before** garbage day – Monday.
